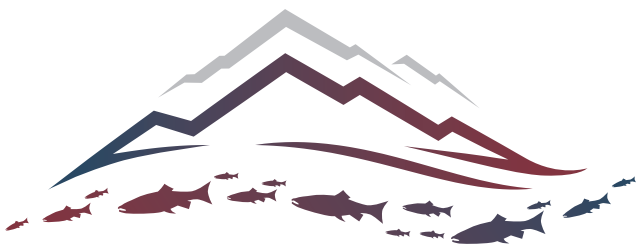

# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Two positions on the CRNA Board of Directors are up for Election in 2020: the President and the Secretary/Treasurer. Information on the election process will be distributed at a later date.

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Interested and eligible individuals are invited to declare candidacy or submit nominations by  
**4:30 pm on April 15, 2020.**

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## Candidacy Declaration or Nomination Options:

- Declare your intention in writing with 3 signatures of adult members of your member village or;
- A member village may nominate a candidate in writing by letter or resolution of the member tribe or;
- Three members of a village may nominate a fellow tribal member in writing.

## President, 2 year term (2020-2022)

The President shall preside over all meetings of the Board of Directors. He or she may sign, with the Secretary/Treasurer or any other proper officer of the Corporation authorized by the Board of Directors, any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the Board of Directors has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be delegated by the Board of Directors or by these Bylaws or by statute to some other officer or agent of the Corporation. In general, the President shall perform all duties incidental to the office of President and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors from time to time, and shall work closely with the CEO.

## Secretary/Treasurer, 2 year term (2020-2022)

The Secretary/Treasurer shall be responsible for seeing to it that the minutes of the Board meetings are reviewed for accuracy, corrected if necessary, and approved by the Board of Directors, and indicate Board approval by signing and sealing said minutes before their entry into the official minute book of the Corporation. The Secretary/Treasurer shall also sign on behalf of the Corporation such other documents as the law requires, and shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as the Board of Directors may prescribe. The Secretary/Treasurer may act as President for regular Board meetings in the absence of the President and Vice-President.

## Eligibility criteria include:

- Must be an Alaska Native and tribal member of a member village.
- Must physically reside in the Ahtna region.
- Must have a high school diploma or GED.
- Send short biography to your Village Council.
- Be prepared to deliver 5 minute or less speech at Annual Meeting.
- Must successfully pass an Alaska Barrier Crimes criminal background check.
- Must meet the eligibility requirements of the Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act.
- Must submit to drug and alcohol testing and a fingerprint based background check **no later than April 22, 2020.**
