## SIMILARITIES

- Fever
- Shortness of Breath
- Cough
- Fatigue

## DIFFERENCES

Flu:

- A person may experience symptoms 1-4 days after infection.
- People are contagious for 1 day before showing symptoms.

COVID-19:

- A person may experience symptoms 2-14 days after infection.
- People are contagious 2-3 days before showing symptoms.
